


You'll be mailed a Census questionnaire this spring. *

Every 10 years, the United States counts everyone living in the United States through the U.S. Census, as directed by the Constitution.



Simple



10 questions, 10 minutes to complete. You provide numbers and information about your household.

Secure



By law, the Census Bureau cannot share your responses with *anyone*.

Size Counts



You tell the government how many people live here.

Our population affects

Federal and state dollars that support our roads, bus system, human needs, and many other services.

Our government representation.

The Census sets the boundaries for federal, state, and local legislative districts.

No Matter Where You're From, You're Counted Here

The Census counts you where you are living as of April 1. Don't expect to be counted someplace else.
