Local Law No. 3 of the year 19 81

A local law of the County of Tompkins, State of New York, authorizing the County to sell or lease County property no longer needed for public use for adequate consideration to an entity or entities without public bidding.

Be it enacted by the Board of Representatives of the

- Section 1. The County of Tompkins is authorized to lease or sell County real property no longer needed for public use for adequate consideration to a private entity or entities without bidding, provided that the County shall first determine that said property is no longer needed for public use in accordance with Section 215 of the County Law.
- Section 2. Notice of the meeting at which the Board will consider the determination that a particular parcel is no longer needed for public use shall be advertised in the official newspapers ten (10) days in advance of the meeting.
- Section 3. This local law is adopted subject to permissive referendum pursuant to Section 24 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that a local law of the County of Tompkins, State of New York, authorizing the County to sell or lease County property no longer needed for public use for adequate consideration to an entity or entities without public bidding was adopted by the Board of Representatives on April 13, 1981.
BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Representatives of the County of Tompkins as follows: Section 1. The county of Tompkins is authorized to lease or sell County real property no longer needed for public use for adequate consideration to a private entity or entities without bidding, provided that the County shall first determine that said property is no longer needed for public use in accordance with Section 215 of the County Law.
Section 2. Notice of the meeting at which the Board will consider the determination that a particular parcel is no longer needed for public use shall be advertised in the official newspapers ten (10) days in advance of the meeting.
Section 3. This local law is adopted subject to permissive referendum pursuant to Section 24 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
