**RESOLUTION NO. 1-2000 – ADOPTION OF THE UNIQUE NATURAL AREAS
INVENTORY, REVISED, JANUARY 2000**

WHEREAS, The Tompkins County Environmental Management Council (EMC) has prepared a report entitled “Unique Natural Areas Inventory, Revised, January 2000,” which identifies and describes areas in Tompkins County that exhibit outstanding environmental qualities and deserve special attention for preservation in their natural state, and

WHEREAS, The preparation and completion of the 2000 Inventory has been a priority of the EMC for several years, and is the product of innumerable hours of volunteer, consultant and staff work, and

WHEREAS, The 2000 Unique Natural Areas (UNA) Inventory is a thorough revision of the 1990 UNA Inventory, containing significant amounts of new and substantially improved information on the sites, and

WHEREAS, It is the hope of the EMC that the publication of the 2000 Inventory will alert citizens to the need to protect these valuable resources, now therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the EMC hereby adopts and endorses the use of the Unique Natural Areas Inventory, Revised, January 2000, as a planning tool by municipalities and other organizations.
