


Tompkins County Transit and Low Income Households

"Low Income" is defined as $\leq 80\%$ of county median income. For 1990, median income for Tompkins County was \$27,742. Low income for the County was defined as less than or equal to \$22,500 to comply with Census population counts by income range. "Minority Population" is defined as the Census-defined total population minus the Census-defined white population.
