Update of Federal Transit Administration Tables – Section 5309

State of Good Repair Grant for \$4.5 Million

D2012-BUSP-155

The Policy Committee of the Ithaca-Tompkins County Transportation Council (ITCTC) approved a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) amendment on **October 16, 2012** during a regularly scheduled meeting. Tompkins County as FTA grant manager, in coordination with the City of Ithaca and Tompkins Consolidated Area Transit (TCAT), requested an amendment to the 2011-2015 TIP and 2011-2014 STIP to update the Federal Transit Administration program summary tables.

Amendment Description:

Tompkins County, in coordination with the City of Ithaca and Tompkins Consolidated Area Transit, requests an amendment to the Section 5309 grant in the 2011-2015 TIP FTA Tables in order to add a new activity and authorize a \$4,500,000 State of Good Repair grant (Project ID D2012-BUSP-155) to be programmed in FFY 2013 as shown in the attached table. This project is assigned NYSDOT PIN 382409. The amendment enables Tompkins County, City of Ithaca and TCAT to:

- Accept the Ithaca Transportation Hub-Accelerating Community Access (ITHACA) Transit Enhancements Project, published in Federal Register, Vol. 77, No. 157, August 14, 2012, pp 48592 and 48597.
- Include the FTA grant in a larger ITHACA Project Budget.
- Reconstruct the Ithaca Commons, construct new public transit facilities, deploy ITS systems for real time passenger information and traffic signal prioritization and procure two replacement buses for TCAT for enhanced service along East Hill corridors to Cornell University.

This amendment will not affect the funding of projects within any other jurisdiction. The tables in Attachment A show the proposed updated tables. The TIP and STIP will remain fiscally constrained.
