****Amendment****

New York State Dept. of Transportation Cyclical Highway Maintenance/Bridge Painting Project

The Policy Committee of the Ithaca-Tompkins County Transportation Council (ITCTC) approved a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Amendment on **December 18, 2012**, during a regularly scheduled meeting. The action on the 2011-2015 TIP and the current State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) affect one project: Cyclical Highway Maintenance/Bridge Painting (PIN: 380622).

Description:

NYSDOT has requested the deletion of a project - Cyclical Highway Maintenance/Bridge Painting (PIN: 380622). This *regional project* was originally expected to include work in some bridges in Tompkins County. As this project progressed, it was determined that none of the bridges in the scope of work are in Tompkins County. Therefore, the project can be removed from the ITCTC TIP.

The proposed amendment is shown in the table below. The project will be deleted from the ITCTC 2011-15 TIP and STIP. The TIP and STIP will remain fiscally constrained.
