**RESOLUTION NO. \_\_\_\_\_ AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT AN ANONYMOUS GRANT TO PURCHASE A SPEED TRAILER**

**WHEREAS**, since April of this year the Sheriff's Office has been using one speed trailer to cover four hundred eighty five square miles of the County, exclusive of city and village jurisdictions, and

**WHEREAS**, the overwhelming public demand for the reduction in speed necessitates the purchase of an additional speed trailer, and

**WHEREAS**, the Tompkins County Sheriff's Office applied for grant monies from an anonymous agency in the amount of \$8,000 and,

**WHEREAS**, the grant monies will be used to purchase a speed trailer for a total cost of \$10,000 to \$12,000 and,

**WHEREAS**, the Tompkins County Sheriff's Office 2001 budget will provide the balance of the money to purchase the speed trailer to benefit the residents of Tompkins County, now therefore be it

**RESOLVED**, on the recommendation of the Public Safety Committee, that the county endorse the grant application of \$8,000 to be used for the purpose of the aforementioned grant.
