

Work and Career Readiness

This guide to research, reports, opinions, and data concerning Work and Career Readiness and the Skills Gap is meant to further the discussion of how to progress our labor market and labor force into the 21st Century. This conversation includes stakeholders from all perspectives of the Labor Market: Businesses, Workers, Educational Institution (traditional and non-traditional), and Workforce Development Partners. This document is meant as an introduction to the debate that has been present since at least the late 90's and resurfaced with mainstream intensity during and after the most recent recession.

The conversation being had regarding whether or not there are gaps in our labor market pipeline and what solutions will fill those gaps in best hinges on several major questions, not the least of which is, "How do we define Skills Gap/Work Readiness?" These questions, as do many of these resources, take place at a very macro level. Often times the authors frame case studies as if they are generalizable at a national level and sometimes they are. While some of the issue is national or even global, much of a skills gap takes place at a state or even regional level: ensuring that communities are producing workers capable of the jobs required by historic business partners through communication and compromise with regard to training programs and skill standards.

This list of resources is broken down and organized by category for ease of use. First in the list are the Research resources. These articles are mostly data, cases, perspectives, evidence, or definitions for the causes Skills Gap and issues with Work Readiness.

Last you will find the Solutions that have been proposed by think tanks, professional organizations, commentators, experts, researchers, and more casual observers. Though some have more convincing evidence than others, none have been seen to be a silver bullet. Between these two sections you will find the articles and publications, which seem to equally provide evidence and suggest a solution. The distinction between these categories is debatable and blurry at best.

To provide slightly more clarity each article has been organized into sub-categories each one representing one of three primary stakeholders in this debate: Businesses (Bus), Educational Organizations (Edu), and the Supply of Labor (Labor), which includes both workers and workforce development organizations. You will see these sub-categories denoted in parentheses with the abbreviations Bus, Edu, and Labor. The sub-categories were not added to suggest that readers look for Sub-categories but were added to provide the reader with a frame of reference for the author's intended audience.

The conversation, like the research that went into it, is multi-faceted and as complex as the people and organizations it affects. By working across industry and sector it is possible to strategically build the dynamic workforce, which will drive our businesses, our careers, and our country into the future.
