INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Mark only with a black or blue pen.

2. To vote for a candidate whose name is printed on this ballot fill in the oval above or next to the name of the candidate.

3. To vote for a person whose name is not printed on this ballot write or stamp his or her name in the space labeled "Write-In" that appears at the bottom of the candidate names for such office.

4. Any other mark or writing, or any erasure made on this ballot outside the voting ovals or blank spaces provided for voting will void this entire ballot.

5. Do not overvote. If you select a greater number of candidates than there are vacancies to be filled, your ballot will be void for that public office, party position or proposal.

6. If you tear, or deface, or wrongly mark this ballot, call the Board of Elections at (607) 274-5521 or (607) 274-5522 for instructions on how to obtain a new ballot. Do not attempt to correct mistakes on the ballot by making erasures or cross outs. Erasures or cross outs may invalidate all or part of your ballot. Prior to submitting your ballot, if you make a mistake in completing the ballot or wish to change your ballot choices, you may obtain and complete a new ballot. You have a right to a replacement ballot.

7. After completing the ballot, fold it and enclose it in the envelope bearing the Voter's Statement, seal it, fill out properly, and sign your name. Enclose that envelope in the envelope addressed to the Board of Elections and promptly mail it. To be counted, ballots must be postmarked no later than the day before the Election, and received by the Tompkins County Board of Elections by no later than seven days after Election Day.
