## VOTER IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

In 2002, to reform and improve the election process, the Federal Government created the Help America Vote Act (HAVA).

Under this act, voters are now required to provide identification when registering to vote.

Voters who did not provide ID when registering to vote will be flagged as needing to provide ID before signing in on the poll pad.

The following are examples of acceptable forms of ID:

- Driver's license
- Passport
- Pistol or Firearm permit
- Government ID

- Non-drivers ID card
- Student ID
- Military ID
- Pilot's license

Only photo IDs are acceptable.

If the voter is unwilling or unable to show some form of ID they may then vote by Affidavit Ballot.

DO NOT allow them to sign in on the electronic Poll Pad. Refer the voter to a Poll Site Manager.
