# **APPROVAL OF MINUTES – October 6, 2020**

## **UPDATE ON COVID-19/WORKFORCE**

Ms. Branosky reported that the unemployment rate for Tompkins County has decreased 2 ½% down to 7% and looking at in house staffing with COVID PPE in place. The NYSDOL staff at the Career Center have returned with one supervisor on full time and rotation of one staff at a time. NYSDOL staff are still working on unemployment claims and the Career Center is not open to customer currently.
