To vote on a proposal, if any, that appears on the back, fill in the oval that corresponds to your "Yes" or "No" vote. 5. Any other mark or writing, or any erasure made on this ballot outside the voting ovals or blank spaces provided for voting may void this entire ballot. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 6. Do not overvote. If you select a greater number of candidates than there are vacancies to be filled, your ballot will be void for that public office, party position or proposal. 7. If you tear, or deface, or wrongly mark this ballot, call the Board of Elections for instructions on how to obtain a new ballot. Do not attempt to correct mistakes on the ballot by making erasures or cross outs. Erasures or cross outs may invalidate all or part of your ballot. Prior to submitting your ballot, if you make a mistake in completing the ballot or wish to change your ballot choices, you may obtain and complete a new ballot. You have a right to a replacement ballot upon return of the original. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 8. To be counted, absentee ballots returned by mail must be postmarked no later than the day of election and be received by the County Board of Elections no later than 7 days after election day. 9. After marking the ballot, fold such ballot and enclose it in the envelope bearing the voter's statement, and seal the envelope. 10. Fill in properly the blanks in the statement and SIGN YOUR NAME. 11. Enclose the sealed envelope bearing the statement in the envelope addressed to the County Board of Elections and mail promptly.
