Registration by Mail - Forms for Registration by mail may be obtained at the following offices: Board of Elections, Town Clerk, Village Clerk, Chamber of Commerce, Dept. of Motor Vehicles and other State Agencies providing services to the public.

Absentee Voting - Civilians may qualify to vote by absentee ballot if their duties, occupation, or business requires them to be away from their county of residence, or if they are on vacation on the day of any Village Election. (Including spouse, parent or child accompanying such person).

Applications for absentee ballots to be mailed to the voter must be received by the Board of Elections no later than seven days before the election. If the applicant or the applicant's agent delivers the application to the Board of Elections in person, such application must be received no later than the day before the election. All absentee ballot envelopes must be postmarked no later than the day before the election.
