



Early Voting: 2024 General Election



Voters have **nine extra days** to vote prior to the General Election to be held on November 5, 2024, at either of our two Early Voting locations. Everyone who is registered to vote in New York State and a resident of Tompkins County is eligible to vote. Each site is fully accessible to voters with physical disabilities. Voters do not need to have an “excuse” for voting early. Once voters have cast their ballot on a machine at an Early Voting site, they will not be able to vote on Election Day.
