To-Date COVID-19 Positive Cases (808 Total)

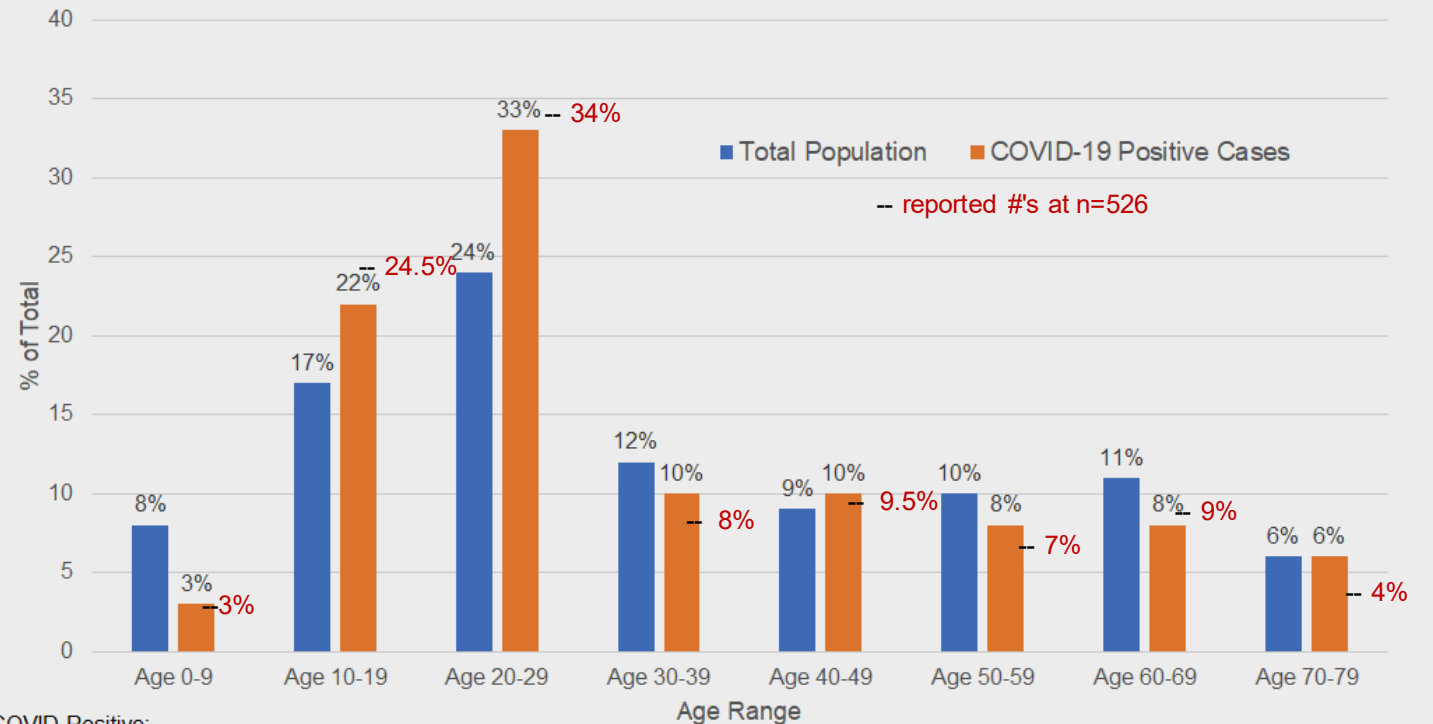

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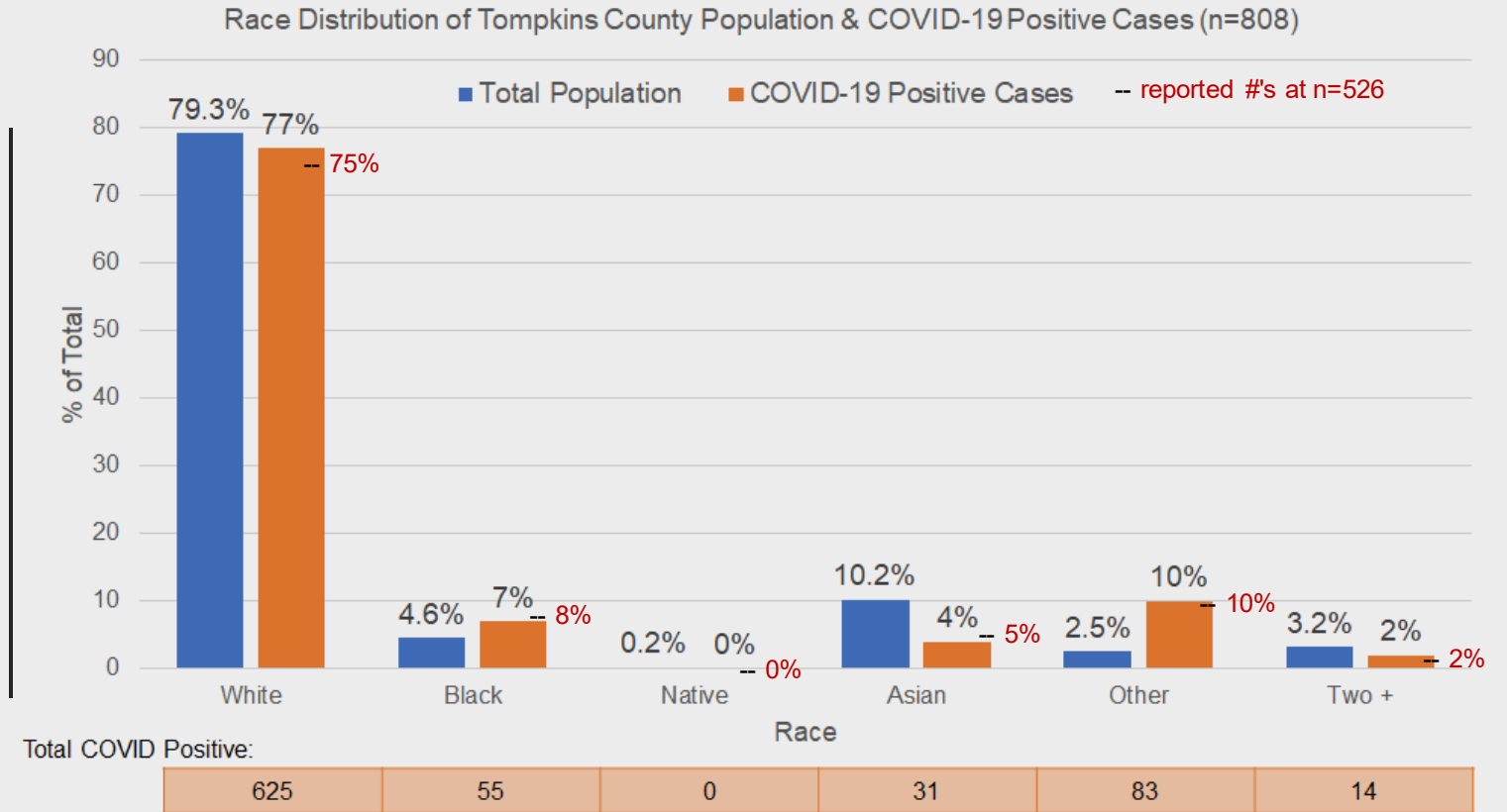

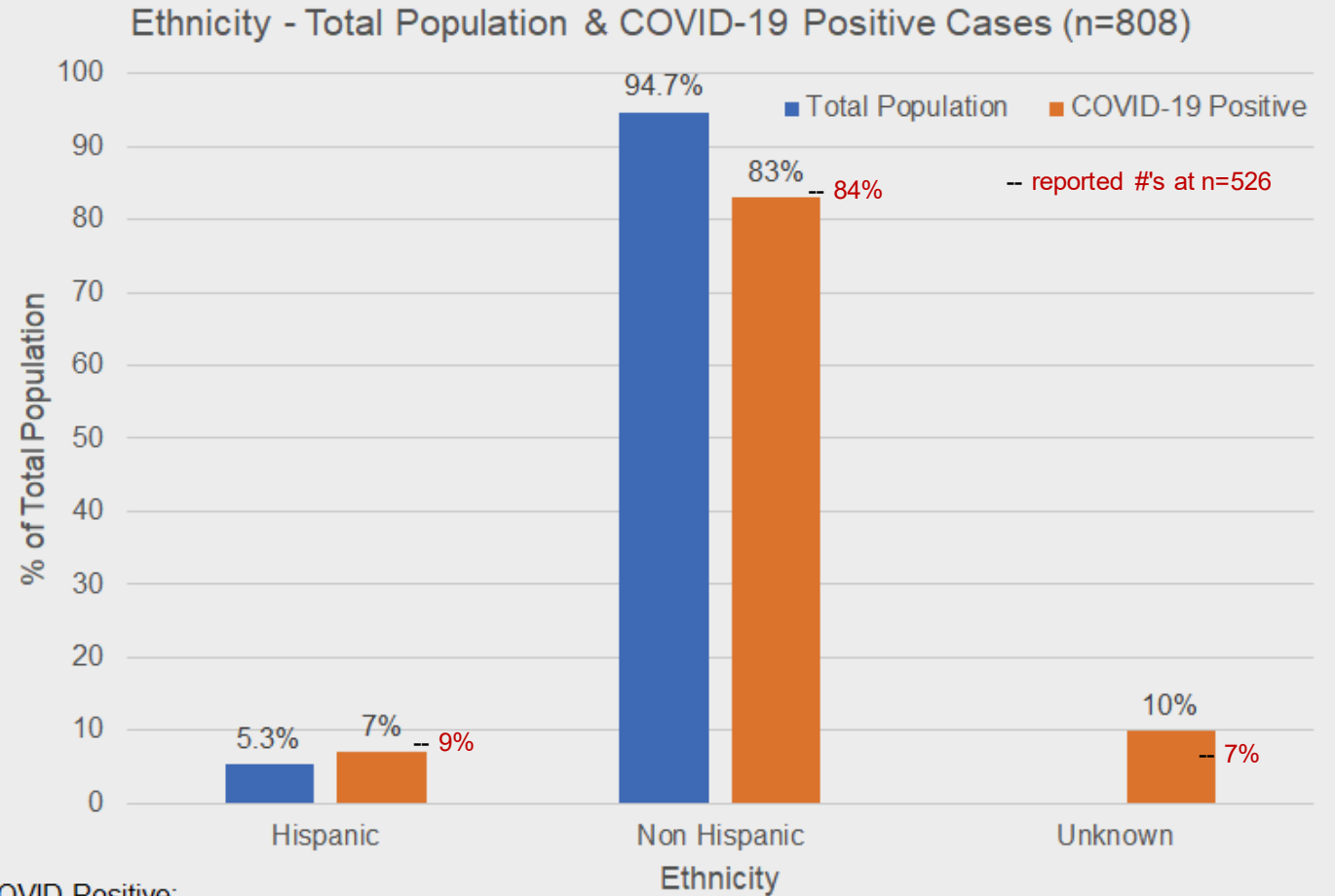

Ethnicity

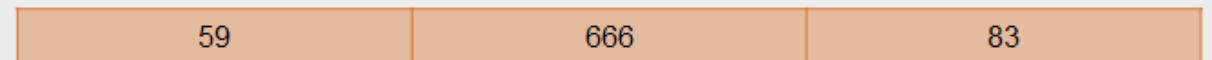

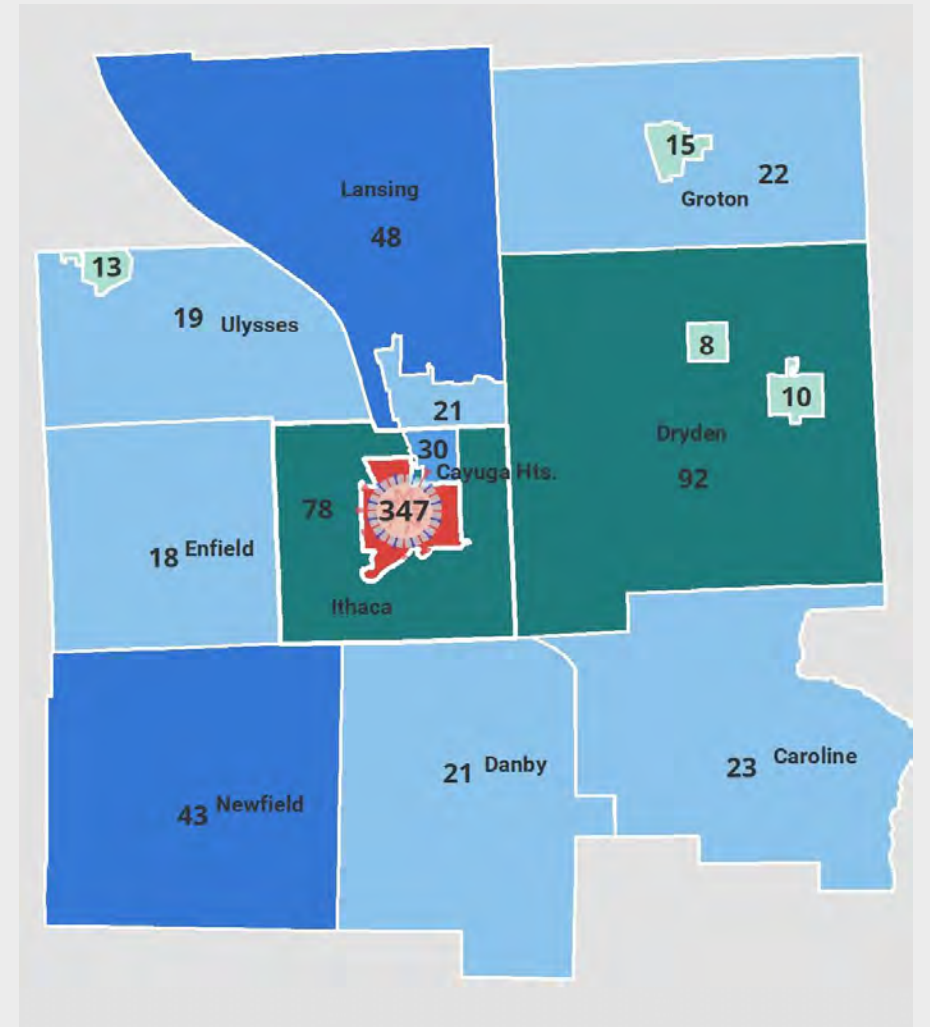

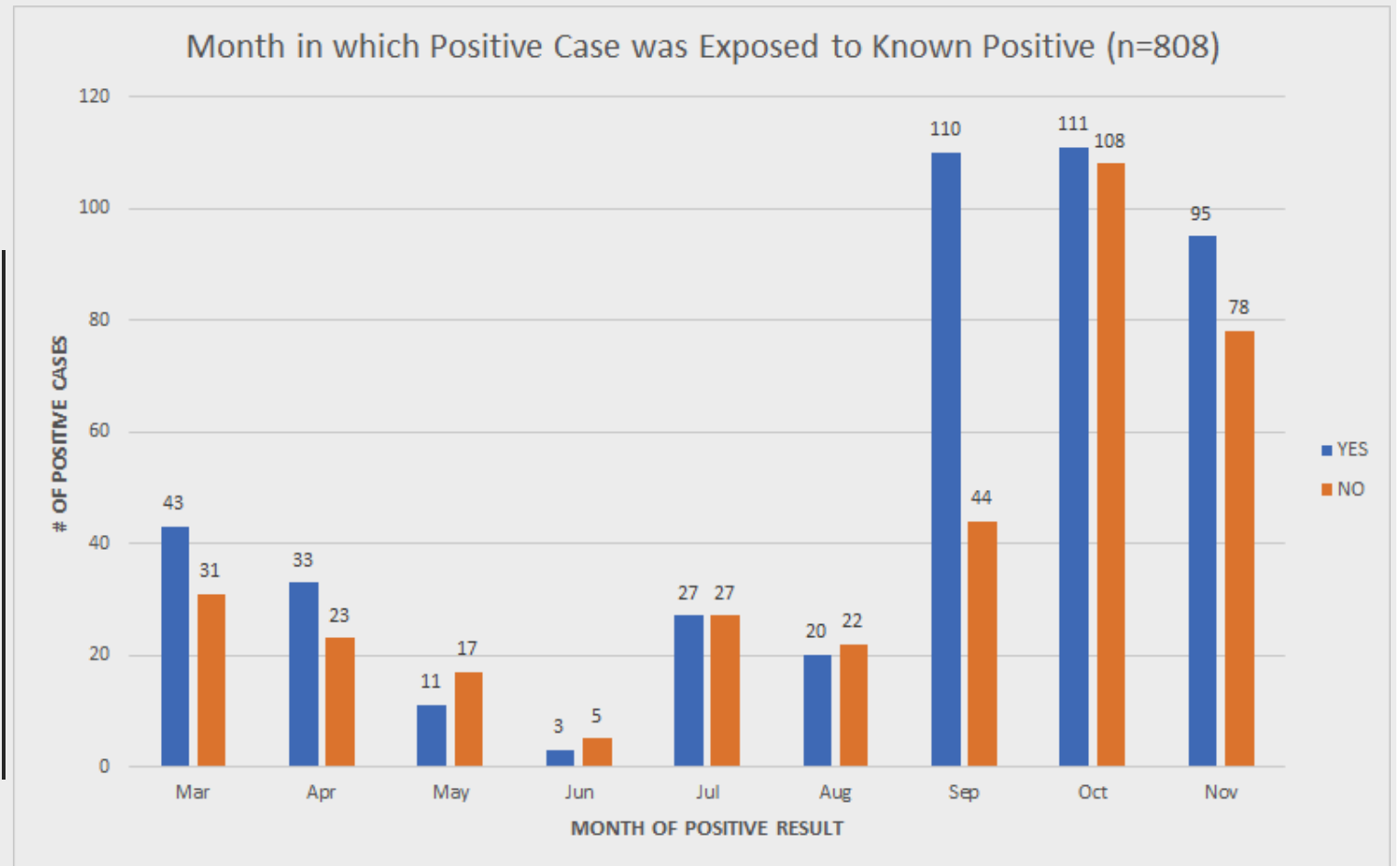


To-Date COVID-19 Positive Cases (808 Total)
