Acknowledgement of 2021 Changes to Tompkins County Retiree Health Insurance Benefits

I hereby acknowledge that I have received notice of the coming changes to the retiree health insurance benefits available to Tompkins County retirees in 2021. I understand that:

- The method of rate calculation for <u>Non-Medicare-eligible Individual and Family Plans</u> has been simplified for ease of administration. (*The new method of rate calculation results in equal or lower rates for retirees than the current method.*)
- Any <u>Medicare-eligible person</u> currently on <u>Individual coverage</u> or <u>Family coverage with</u>
 <u>just one other person</u> will move to the new <u>MS4 Medicare Supplement Plan</u>. (For example,
 <u>two Medicare-eligible spouses</u> currently on a <u>Classic Blue Family Plan</u> will move to <u>two</u>
 <u>Individual MS4 Medicare Supplement Plans</u>.)
- Any <u>Non-Medicare-eligible person</u> currently on <u>Family coverage with just one Medicare-eligible person</u> will move to a <u>Platinum Individual Plan</u> until becoming <u>Medicare-eligible</u> or <u>attaining age 26 (child)</u>. (For example, a <u>Medicare-eligible retiree</u> and their <u>non-Medicare-eligible spouse</u> currently on the <u>PPO Family Plan</u> will move to an <u>Individual MS4 Medicare Supplement Plan (retiree)</u> and an <u>Individual Platinum Plan (spouse)</u>.
- Any <u>family of three or more with at least one Medicare-eligible person on coverage</u> will move to a <u>Platinum Family Plan</u>. (For example, <u>two Medicare-eligible spouses their child</u> currently on a Classic Blue Family Plan will move to a Platinum Family Plan.)
