<u>Opening Remarks/Changes to the Agenda/Privilege of the Floor</u> – Vice Chair Doug Levine welcomed everyone to the meeting at 3:02 pm. No changes to the agenda. No privilege of the floor but there was a quick round of introductions.

<u>Action: Approval of Feb. 15, 2023 STPB Draft Minutes</u> – The draft February 2023 minutes were approved as submitted (moved by Josh Friedman, seconded by Greg Mezey).

Vice Chair's Report - Doug Levine

No report.

Staff Report – Nick Helmholdt

Nick reported on grant review and budget committee meetings, appointments of Mike Sigler as legislative liaison and Jason Sidle as TC3 representative* (*effective 4/18/23), and the Ithaca Area Economic Development task force.

<u>Presentation: CVB 2022 Annual Report</u> – Peggy Coleman

Peggy, along with CVB staff Erin Rafalowski and Jodi LaPierre, shared highlights from the 2022 CVB Annual Report. Their presentation covered the move to their new offices on Brindley Street in the West End; the team's advocacy on behalf of local and regional tourism sector on issues such as workforce development, infrastructure and housing, and destination management; conference and sales team activity; growing visitor experience through initiatives like Ithaca Loves Teachers and incorporating accessibility into CVB

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offerings; community engagement through the Visit Ithaca website and social media platforms; inclusive marketing and advertising campaigns; public relations and earned media; collaboration with area partners on downtown conference center; support for local agriculinary tourism through Farm to Fork microgrants; and more.

Monika Roth and Marian Ware departed from the meeting before board voted on following action items.

Report/Action: Community Celebrations Grant Review Committee – Doug Levine

Doug reported on the applications submitted in this grant round and thanked his fellow committee members and County staff for their support of the Community Celebrations program.

Action: Kelly Makosch made a motion, which Josh Friedman seconded, to recommend the 2023 Spring Community Celebrations grant awards be approved for funding. Motion carried by members present, with Doug Levine abstaining.

Report/Action: Tourism Advancement Grant Committee - Nick Helmholdt

Nick gave an overview of the new Tourism Advancement grant program, summarized the applications submitted in this round, and thanked committee members for their service.

Action: Josh Friedman made a motion, which Teri Tarshus seconded, to recommend the 2023 Tourism Advancement grant awards be approved for funding. Motion carried by members present, with Steven Stull abstaining.

Budget Committee – Kelli Cartmill

Members reported on an amendment to the 2023 Tourism Program budget proposing that unspent funds from 2022 be moved into the current year. Nick shared highlights from the Budget Committee memo, which was included in the meeting agenda packet and breaks down into more detail how the funds would be distributed. Committee report and group discussion covered multiple topics, including budget forecasting, committee decision-making process and meeting timeline, stabilization of local arts organizations, ARPA, Community Recovery Fund, workforce concerns, visitor profile study, the reserve fund balance, and more.

Action: Ken Jupiter made a motion, which Steven Stull seconded, to recommend budget adjustment that allocates unspent room tax from 2022 into the current 2023 budget. Motion carried, with Kelly Makosch abstaining.

Member Announcements

Members shared news and events of interest. These included a waterfront cleanup event at Stewart Park, free Marvel screening at State Theatre, Dead & Company benefit concert at Barton Hall, vernal equinox open dance class at Triphammer Arts, a Rising Star award for the CVB's Lisa Conarton from the Upstate New York chapter of Meeting Planners International, minimum wage legislation, and more. It was also shared that Gary Ferguson is the recipient of the 2023 Howard Cogan Tourism Award.
